RESOLUTION NO. 484

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of the Washington State Major League Baseball Stadium Public Facilities District ratifying and authorizing the Executive Director to enter into a services contract with Parallel Public Works for a website redesign and logo refresh.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 36.100 RCW, as amended, the Washington State Major League Baseball Stadium Public Facilities District (the "District"), has been created and possesses all the powers of a public facilities district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 36.100.010(5), RCW 36.100.180 and other provisions of state law, the District has broad powers to enter into contracts for materials, work and services necessary for the operations of the ballpark; and

WHEREAS, District Resolutions authorize the Executive Director to contract for professional services, subject to ratification by the District Board; and

WHEREAS, all contracts in excess of \$50,000, regardless of how procured, require Board approval or ratification; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the District's procurement process and RCW 36.100.180, the Executive Director requested proposals from firms for consulting services for a website redesign and logo refresh; and

WHEREAS, notice of this RFP was duly published as required in the Daily Journal of Commerce on June 1 and 9, 2020 and was distributed to multiple consulting firms with known expertise in website redesign and logo refresh services for public and/or non-profit agencies; and

WHEREAS, nineteen (19) consulting firms responded to the RFP: Sprout Partners, 1212 Design, Business Marketing Solutions Group, Ameex Technologies Corporation, SiteCrafting, Trinity, Park Circle Technologies, Creative Arcade, Mobikasa, Nandaan, WCS Custom Solutions, Grova Creative, Unified Development, LRS Web Solutions, Parallel Public Works, Invasion Digital Media, Hornsby Design, DEV.co, and 1205 Marketing; and

WHEREAS, the District's legal counsel, Tom Backer, reviewed the initial round of applications and met with Board members Carol Nelson and Chris Marr to review and evaluate the highest ranked written responses received; and

WHEREAS, Board members Stacy Graven, Carol Nelson, and Chris Marr, supported by the District's legal counsel, Tom Backer, and the District's Executive Director, Joshua Curtis, held interviews with two finalists; and

WHEREAS, Board members Stacy Graven, Carol Nelson, and Chris Marr, based on the written proposals and interviews, recommended that Parallel Public Works be retained to provide website redesign and logo refresh services to the District; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director was directed to develop a contract between the District and Parallel Public Works consistent with the scope identified in the RFP; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the District and consistent with the District's procurement procedures and policies to ratify and authorize the Executive Director's contracting with Parallel Public Works for these services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WASHINGTON STATE MAJOR LEAGUE BASEBALL STADIUM PUBLIC FACILITIES DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Executive Director's retention of the consulting firm of Parallel Public Works to provide website redesign and logo refresh services for the District is hereby ratified and authorized.
